



## **Escaping Poverty Traps**

*Connecting the Chronically Poor  
to Economic Growth*

**Kate Bird** is an ODI Research Fellow and the Programme Leader of ODI's Growth and Equity Programme (<http://www.odi.org.uk/programmes/growth-equity>). She is a socio-economist with a particular interest in pro-poor growth. Her current work is exploring the social and poverty implications of trade policy change and the aid for trade agenda. She also leads work on ex ante tools for poverty and social impact analysis and on chronic and intergenerationally transmitted poverty, rural livelihoods, coping strategies and diversification. Her work leading the CPRC's research into spatial poverty traps delivered insights into intrahousehold and intergenerational drivers of poverty. She now leads the Centre's interdisciplinary and multi-country work on IGT poverty.
