Gáspár Fajth is Chief, Social Policy and Economic Analysis at UNICEF's headquarters' Policy and Practice group in New York. He is responsible for promoting UNICEF's engagement in socioeconomic analysis and advocacy (including, for example, through UNICEF's global study on child poverty which is currently being carried out in more than 40 low and middle income countries).
