Alonzo L. Fulgham has been designated by the White House as the Acting Administrator of USAID. Fulgham concurrently serves as Coordinator of the Agency's Transition Efforts and as Chief Operating Officer (COO) and Executive Secretary. Fulgham also served as a Commissioner of the bipartisan, Congressional Commission for **H**elping to **E**nhance the **L**ivelihood of **P**eople Around the Globe (the HELP Commission). Fulgham is a member of the Senior Foreign Service. He served as Mission Director in Afghanistan from June 2005 to July 2006. Prior to that, he served as the Director for South Asian Affairs in the Bureau for Asia and the Near East (ANE). In 2003, he joined the ANE Bureau as Special Assistant to the Assistant Administrator for Asia and the Near East, Ambassador Wendy Chamberlin. Fulgham also has served as acting USAID Deputy Director for Serbia and Montenegro, in Jordan as Director responsible for economic policy and poverty reduction, and in the Regional Mission for the Caucasus as Director for Economic Restructuring and Energy, responsible for Georgia and Azerbaijan.
